



Floater (Substitute Teacher)

Responsibilities:

- In partnership with the classroom teacher, provide for and ensure child safety, care, and well-being in the classroom environment.
- Assist teacher in executing age-appropriate, standards-based academic and social-emotional lessons for children with and without special needs in an inclusive learning environment.
- Model compassion, empathy, care, and respect for each child through actions and words.
- Provide appropriate physical care for children. Depending on age and need, this may include diapering, feeding, and general physical care.
- Communicate effectively with other adults serving students within the educational environment, including other teachers, co-teachers, therapists, parents, and administrators.
- Provide detailed notes on each child about their day and communicate those with parents via online app.

Requirement:

- As a floater (substitute teacher), be willing to receive classroom assignments on the day of.

Qualifications:

- Prior experience working with children preferred.

Skills:

- Ability to multi-task
- Flexible to work in varying classroom environments and with varying personalities daily
- Strong adult communication skills
- Ability to communicate well with children
